## **Overview**

Kathmandu Valley Tour transfers you to all the interesting tourist attractions that you deserve to see as a tourist when you are in Kathmandu, Bhaktapur, and Lalitpur which are located close to one another. Each of these lies in the Valley of Kathmandu, and they all look like the consolidation of one district. When you visit their major highlights within one day or more, they are not to be understated because what makes them so overestimated is that they abound with historical monuments, such as temples, stupas, palaces, and museums, which are more than a thousand years old, and which bemuse your eyes with their architectural wonders and the stories, associated with the supernatural powers of gods, goddess, and kings. As a visitor, you do not have to necessarily refer to this power; however, their stories will hook you with endless interest.

Kathmandu, where you land for the first time in Nepal from your country to enjoy Kathmandu Valley Tour, has thankful of temples; therefore, it is known as "The City of Temples." Along with temples, there are palaces, where you can walk freely in their courtyards as the kings and queens used to in the past, and where you see beautiful windows and wooden crafts, made by the famous Nepalese architectures of that period as if they were on display to show you their skills right from the beginning. Made from a single tree, there is Kastamandap. AMAZING, isn't it? Be sure to pose with it in front of your camera.

Kathmandu Valley Tour does not limit historical monuments; it stretches to include Nagarkot, a nice hill

station, and it has a brilliant viewpoint from where you can see the stunning view of a group of mountains, including Everest. Fascinating exhibits other mountains, such as the Annapurna Ranges, Manaslu Ranges, Ganesh Himal Range, Langtang Range, Jugal Range, Rolwaling Range, and Number Range, besides the views of the Valley of Kathmandu and the Shivapuri National Park, including the major attractions of this valley.

## **Itinerary**

### **Day 01: Arrival Kathmandu and transferred to Hotel**

Welcome to Kathmandu, the city of temples. Our airport representative will receive you at the airport, transfer you to the hotel and brief you about tomorrow's activities. If you have any questions, please ask to a representative. Overnight at hotel inclusive breakfast.

### **Day 02: Visit Swoyambhunath, Pashupatinath, Bouddhanath and Kathmandu durbar square**

After breakfast, our city guide will take you to the monuments and places that come under the category of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites of Kathmandu. You will visit Kathmandu Durbar Square, where you might see "Kumari", the living goddess, as well as visit pagoda style temples. After that you will visit Pashupatinath temple, one of the biggest and popular Hindus temples of Nepal and thousands of devotees visit this temple everyday. You might see cremation taking place on the bank of the Bagmati River. From here, you move towards Bouddhanath stupa, one of the largest Buddhist stupas in the world where over 50 Tibetan Gompas or monasteries are located. Back to the hotel for overnight with bed and breakfast.

### **Day 03: Visit Patan and Bhaktapur then drive to Nagarkot.**

Today you will explore Patan Durbar Square, one of the important UNESCO world heritage sites. This square is an ancient royal palace of Lalitpur kings and is a marvel of Newari architecture. The main attractions of this palace are Krishna temple, Bhimsen temple, Taleju Bhawani temple and Bishwonath temple. Then, our city guide will take you to Bhaktapur. Bhaktapur Durbar Square is one of the important and highly visited UNESCO World Heritage Sites. One and half hour is enough to explore the attractions of this palace, such as 55 windows palace, golden gate, lions gate, Natyapola temple and Bhairava Nath temple. After this, drive to Nagarkot by private car for sunrise and mountain views. Overnight at hotel with full board meals.

### **Day 04: Drive to Namobuddha**

Early in the morning hike to the hill station for breathtaking sunrise views over the Himalayan ranges including Mount Everest. Then after, back to hotel for breakfast and then you will head off to Namobuddha by car. In Namobuddha, you visit Thangu Tashi Yangtse Monastery, one of the most important

Buddhist pilgrimage sites in Nepal. It is the place where the Lord Buddha gave his body to a starving tigress and her cubs. And this is what makes Namu Boudha famous. Overnight at lodge with full board meals.

### **Day 05: Drive back to Kathmandu and rest day**

After breakfast, you will drive back to Kathmandu. Enjoy farewell dinner party in the evening. Overnight at hotel inclusive breakfast and dinner.

### **Day 06: Departure Day**

Our airport representative will pick you up from the hotel and take you to the airport in a private car. You will reach the airport before 3 hours of departure time.
