## Overview

A wedding day marks the beginning of a new life. It's an occasion where two hearts are brought together to take vows of love, life and happiness. It is not just a bonding of two individuals, but the bonding of two souls and two families. Moreover, it comprises culture, customs, emotions, and celebrations. Being the most important event of life, the ceremony is not just performed but celebrated with great joy and enthusiasm.

## **Distinct features of the wedding in Nepal**

The general setup of the marriage spot consists of a mandap, a canopy with four pillars and Agni - a sacred fire that is considered as a witness of the marriage ceremony. The bride is dressed in red while the groom wears traditional Daura surwal with Dhaka topi on his head. The marriage starts with the arrival of the groom with janti (relatives and friends from the groom's side) and Panche Baja (a traditional musical instrument of Nepal). As the groom arrives, the bride pours water from Kalash and makes three rounds around the groom. Next, the groom and bride exchange garlands put tika to each other, and exchange rings. Here, the swayambar (engagement) part of the marriage ends. Then, the bride and groom are brought to the mandap. They both make seven rounds around the mandap take seven vows of togetherness. After the vows and holy chants of the priest, the bride and groom take the blessings of a happy life from their elders. Finally, the marriage ceremony is over as the groom takes away his bride.

# **Itinerary**

## **Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu**

### **Day 03: Wedding event and drive to Nagarkot**

Are you excited for your big day today? Wake up early and get ready for your wedding day. Few experts from our team will help you with dress up and makeup. After getting ready, you will be escorted to the wedding venue for further rituals. After around half day-long interesting rituals, we have lunch at the venue and spend a while in the venue for wedding photography. Then, you will be driven to Nagarkot for overnight stay. A luxurious suite will be booked for you for your wedding night. Enjoy your night in a fully decorated luxurious room. Tonight at a hotel in Nagarkot.

### **Day 04: Fly to Pokhara and sightseeing tour**

You can also opt for a long boating trip around the lake if interested. In the late evening, you will be escorted to your hotel room with your partner. ### **Day 05: Drive to Sarangkot for sunrise and fly to Chitwan**

Even today, we wake up early for a short drive to Sarangkot. Sarangkot is a beautiful viewpoint that lies just above the Pokhara city. From Sarangkot, we can enjoy some amazing sights of mountains in Annapurna range like Mt. Annapurna, Mt. Macchapucchre, Mt. Dhaulagiri, Mt. Hiunchuli, Mt. Nilgiri and many other mountains. More amazing is the sight of sunrise from amongst those towering peaks in the Annapurna range. We spend some quality time in Sarangkot and then return back to our hotel for breakfast. After breakfast, we head towards Pokhara airport to catch a flight to Bharatpur airport.

As soon as we land in Bharatpur airport and come out of the arrival terminal, we take a short drive to Chitwan National Park. In the park, we will be welcomed by the staff followed by a short introduction session about your time in the national park. After relaxing for a while, we head towards a Tharu community nearby. Here, we can explore Tharu villages and learn about the authentic Tharu culture prevalent in that area. In the early evening, we walk towards the bank of Rapti River for the sunset view and return back to our hotel for dinner. The dinner will be served with a cultural and recreational program at the hotel. Tonight at a hotel in Chitwan National Park.

## **Day 06: Jungle activities**

Get ready for some jungle activities today. After breakfast, we walk towards Rapti River for canoe ride if interested. The bank of Rapti River an excellent opportunity for bird watching. One can see many migrating birds flying over the sky of the river. We can even watch two species of crocodiles namely Marsh Mugger and fish-eating gharial in the river. Next, we head for a jungle walk. It's a rejuvenating time into the pristine and fresh air of the jungle. On the way back, we can enjoy a jovial moment of elephant bathing. After lunch at the hotel, we set out for an elephant safari. If interested, you can opt for a jeep safari instead. It depends on your choice and preference. Jungle safari is an amazing opportunity to explore various species of wildlife in their natural habitat. Here, we can encounter some diverse species of birds and animals like peacock, Wild boar, monkey, sloth bear, leopard, Royal Bengal tiger, Langur monkeys, musk seer, one-horned rhino, etc. After wrapping up with the jungle safari, you will be transferred to your hotel room in the park. Tonight at a hotel in Chitwan National Park.

## **Day 07: Fly back to Kathmandu and sightseeing tour**

In the early morning, we visit the elephant breeding center in the national park. After breakfast, you will be transferred to Bharatpur airport for a flight back to Kathmandu. Upon your arrival, we proceed with a sightseeing tour around the UNESCO listed heritage sites in Kathmandu. We visit different places like Pashupatinath temple, Boudhanath stupa, Swayambhunath stupa and Kathmandu Durbar Square. Swayambhunath stupa and Boudhanath stupa are two Buddhist stupas with a peculiar structure - a huge white dome with a golden spire placed on it. The golden spire has Buddha's eyes looking at four different directions. Boudhanath stupa is placed on three-layered white Mandala while Swayambhunath stupa lies on a hilltop. Likewise, Pashupatinath temple is an old Hindu temple with many old temples and structures built in its periphery area. A visit to this temple is an excellent way of getting some unique insights on Hindu culture. Kathmandu Durbar Square on the other hand is a historical complex full of temples, palaces and courtyards. Here, one can explore the rich art, architecture and paintings of the ancient areas. After the sightseeing tour around these locations, you will be dropped at your hotel. Enjoy your time at the hotel.

## **Day 08: Departure from Nepal**

After a wonderful wedding ceremony followed by a honeymoon tour, it's time for you to return back to your hometown. Hope you had a great time in Nepal.
